



Criteria for All iAdelante! Scholarships 2011-2012

MillerCoors National - \$3,000

- Be eligible for college JUNIOR or SENIOR status by Fall 2011.
- Pursue a degree in the following: International Business, General Business, Economics, Finance, Accounting, Marketing, Public Relations, General Communications, or Sales.
- Must be a US citizen or Legal Permanent Resident.
- Must be of Hispanic descent.
- Have and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above (on a 4.0 scale).
- Maintain full-time enrollment status throughout duration of the scholarship term.
- Provide two letters of recommendation which express leadership potential.
- Participate in Adelante's Annual Leadership Institute in the fall of 2011.
- Attend a Partnering University ([see Partner Institutions](#)).

MillerCoors Engineering & Sciences - \$3,000

- Be eligible for college JUNIOR or SENIOR status by Fall 2011.
- Pursue a degree in the following: Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Computer Science or Bio-Chemistry.
- Must be a US citizen or Legal Permanent Resident.
- Must be of Hispanic descent.
- Have and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above (on a 4.0 scale).
- Maintain full-time enrollment status throughout duration of the scholarship term.
- Provide two letters of recommendation which express leadership potential.
- Participate in Adelante's Annual Leadership Institute in the fall of 2011.
- Attend a Partnering University ([see Partner Institutions](#)).

MillerCoors Chicago - \$1,500

- Open to any incoming freshman or current undergraduate college student.
- Must attend an accredited community college or university in the Chicago Metro area
- Open to all majors
- Must be a US citizen or Legal Permanent Resident.
- Have and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above (on a 4.0 scale).
- Maintain full-time enrollment status throughout duration of the scholarship term.
- Provide two letters of recommendation which express leadership potential.
- Participate in Adelante's Annual Leadership Institute in the fall of 2011.

HOPE Scholarship (CPS Energy Dependents ONLY)- \$1,500 ACCD Students - \$3,000 UTSA Students

- Open to CPS Energy dependents that are incoming freshman or undergraduate college student attending an ACCD community College or the University of Texas at San Antonio ONLY. (Freshmen should provide an acceptance letter and current students must present proof of enrollment.)
- May pursue a degree in any concentration.
- No income requirement is set forth.
- Have and maintain a 2.5 GPA or above based on a 4.0 scale.
- Community service involvement is required.
- Provide two letters of recommendation.
- Must maintain full-time enrollment status throughout the duration of the scholarship term.
- Active or retired CPS Energy guardians or parents must obtain a signature from a HOPE officer on the 2011 Scholarship Eligibility Form found on the CPS Energy Intranet.
- Recipients are required to attend the HOPE Hispanic Heritage Banquet to be held Sept. 22, 2011.
